




PARENTHESES ()	SEMI-COLON ;	COLON :
~ contain information that clarifies or adds to a comment	~ used to connect two related ideas in one sentence	~ usually introduces a list of items
Apostrophe '	ELLIPSES	COMMA ,
~ used to indicate ownership (possessive) or a contraction (don't)	~ used to indicate a pause in thinking or to show the omission of information	 represents a pause usually used to separate list of items used before FANBOYS (For, And, Nor, But, Or, Yet, So) to join two independent clauses.



Can we create or make up facts and examples?

Yes. Absolutely!

You do not have access to the internet or any secondary sources. It is expected that you will create facts/evidence (it has to be realistic) to fit your argument.

For example, as evidence, you could say that in a recent survey 75% of OSS students are not in favour of school uniforms. (It is realistic, but created evidenced)

You could use an example of a cousin that attends a school with uniforms and how she/he feels that they have lost their individuality because of the uniform. It's ok if you don't have a cousin. It's ok if you don't have a cousin that attends a school with uniforms.


